## OPINION

Our laboratory examined both submitted stool samples. We would like to inform you that the laboratory examination result of faecal occult blood in your faeces is **negative**.

A negative result means that your stool samples did not exceed the average recommended value of haemoglobin for a screening test. You will be asked to retake the examination in the Svit Programme two years after you received the invitation to participate in the current screening round.

Please show the laboratory examination result to your GP next time you visit him/her.

**Nevertheless, please look out for any of the following:**

- **Visible bleeding in faeces,**
- **Changes in manner of defecation,**
- **Very thin faeces,**
- **Constipation, followed by diarrhoea,**
- **Severe, repeated or longer lasting stomach pain,**
- **Unintentional loss of body weight or other inexplicable difficulties.**

If you notice any of the above, please consult your GP and do not wait for a new invitation to the Svit Programme. If you have been referred for a colonoscopy outside the Svit Programme, we advise you to undergo the examination despite a negative stool test result.
